

CHURCH ELECTORAL ROLL

In order to be eligible for enrolment you must:

1a. be baptised and aged 16 or over

or

1b. be baptised and will become 16 within 12 months, and so will be entered on the roll on your sixteenth birthday

You must also declare that you are:

2a. a member of the Church of England (or of a Church in communion with the Church of England) and are resident in the parish

or

2b. a member of the Church of England (or of a Church in communion with the Church of England) and, not being resident in the parish, have habitually attended public worship in the parish during the six months prior to enrolment

or:

2c. a member in good standing of a Church (not in communion with the Church of England) which subscribes to the doctrine of the Holy Trinity and also declare yourself to be a member of the Church of England and have habitually attended public worship in the parish during the period of six months prior to enrolment.
